WHERE TO EAT & DRINK...

ASIAN:

- Attack of the Tatsu (downtown)
- Kai Bistro (Southside)

- <u>Shangri-La</u> (downtown) affordable Chinese
- Two Ten Jack (Southside) great ramen

BBO:

- Barque BBQ (Main St.)
- Chatt Smoke House (downtown/MLK) huge portions
- <u>Sugar's Ribs</u> (Missionary Ridge)

BREAKFAST/BRUNCH:

- Aretha Frankenstein's (North Shore) worth the long wait on weekends; go early & get the pancakes!
- Bluegrass Grill (Southside) family-style seating; amazing food; can have long wait times on weekends
- The Daily Ration (North Shore)
- Hungry Mother (downtown/MLK) amazing bagels, breakfast sandwiches & coffee drinks; open Wed-Sun
- Frothy Monkey (Southside) great coffee; upstairs space is great for studying (or people watching)
- Niedlov's (Southside) bakery w/great lunch menu (also Friday night pizza); has a cool outdoor patio

BURGERS:

- Hoppy's North River Corner Market (North Shore) a tiny shop with great burger & breakfast biscuits)
- Main Street Meats (Southside) full-service butcher & restaurant
- Tremont Tavern (North Shore) voted Chattanooga's best burger

COFFEE SHOPS:

- BeCaffeinated (multiple locations)
- Mean Mug (Southside & North Shore) good food; great place to study
- Rembrandt's (Art District) the outdoor courtyard is a relaxing study spot
- Sleepyhead Coffee (downtown) super chill vibe; lots of vegan options (& plants!)
- Velo Coffee Roasters (Southside) coffee shop & espresso bar

DELI:

River Street Deli (North Shore) - Chattanooga's best deli since 1998; legit NY-style deli

FRIED CHICKEN:

• Champy's (downtown, East Ridge, Lee Hwy) - best fried chicken in town; also a very popular sports bar

- Amigo (Brainerd, E. Ridge & Hixson) Chattanooga's Best Mexican Food for 13yrs; each location has specials
- <u>La Alteña Taqueria</u> (Southside) affordable & filling!
- Mexiville (downtown & North Shore) tasty & affordable, esp. the lunch combos

MEDITERRANEAN/MIDDLE EASTERN:

- Acropolis (Hamilton Place Mall)
- Ankar's Hoagies (Hwy. 58) one of Chattanooga's oldest family-owned restaurants
- The Hummus Bowl (St. Elmo/Southside)
- <u>University Pizza & Deli</u> (UTC campus) not just pizza; great Mediterranean food; affordable & filling

PIZZA:

- <u>Community Pie</u> (downtown)
- Crust Pizza (Southside, Red Bank) known for their cracker-thin crust
- Honey Seed wood-fired pizza; also known for their Montreal-style bagels
- <u>Lupi's Pizza</u> (downtown, Hixson, Ooltewah) *try the football-sized calzone!*
- Southside Pizza (Southside)

SEAFOOD:

- Boathouse Rotisserie & Raw Bar (Riverside) excellent food; chill vibes on the patio; free parking
- Scottie's on the River (downtown) good food & cool patio, but you have to pay for parking

SOUTHERN/HOME COOKING:

- Bea's Restaurant an all-you-can-eat Chattanooga institution since 1950; each table is its own buffet!
- Wally's Chattanooga's oldest restaurant (since 1937!); affordable & tasty; 1.5 miles from Erlanger

- <u>Tivoli Theatre</u> (+Memorial Auditorium & Walker Theatre) primary performance venues in Chattanooga

PARKS:

- Camp Jordan (East Ridge)
- Chester Frost Park (Hixson) on Chickamauga Lake
- Cloudland Canyon (Lookout Mtn, GA) 60 miles of trails!
- Coolidge Park (North Shore) carousel rides are only \$1
- Harrison Bay State Park (Harrison) on Chickamauga Lake
- Miller Park (downtown) has live music & free movie nights
- North Chickamauga Creek Gorge State Park (Soddy Daisy)
- Point Park (Lookout Mountain) great scenic photo spots
- Renaissance Park (North Shore) where you can go sledding year-round on "Cardboard Hill"
- Tennessee Riverpark (Riverside) free; 16 miles of cycling/walking trails from Chatt. State to St. Elmo

- Chattanooga Choo Choo free to walk around the venue
- Chattanooga Ducks boat tour
- Chattanooga Zoo
- Classic Arcade Pinball Museum play vintage arcade games
- Hunter Museum of Art free admission after 4pm on the 1st Thursday of the month;
 Student memberships are only \$15/year for students who live within 50 miles of Chattanooga
- Incline Railway train ride up to Lookout Mountain; great views
- Lake Winnepesaukah amusement park in business since 1925
- Naughty Cat Café Chattanooga's only cat café; visitors can chill w/30+ adoptable cats + free drink
- Reflection Riding Arboretum & Nature Center 300 acres of nature only 10mins from downtown
- Rock City Chattanooga's #1 tourist attraction since 1932; great scenic views from Lookout Mtn.
- Ruby Falls Discovered in 1928; largest underground waterfall; cave tours available year-round & ziplines seasonally (Mar-Nov); also offers treehouse lodging
- Tennessee Aquarium
- Tennessee Riverwalk free outdoor paved path with recreation/picnic areas

• Ocoee river rafting - multiple outfitters offer trips on the Ocoee River (about an hour from Chattanooga)

- Chattanooga Market Sunday farmer's market w/live music & food trucks; also
 - Wednesdays in Erlanger Medical Mall (smaller version, no live music)
 - Saturdays at the Aquarium
- Gaining Ground Grocery (Highland Park) non-profit; affordable local produce, meat, dairy & more
- The Gear Closet great deals on used outdoor gear (including refurbished Bonnaroo camping supplies)
- Main Street Farmers Market local vendors every Wednesday 4-6pm @ Finley Stadium
- McKay's (Lee Hwy) best place to buy/sell/trade books, movies, music, games & more; HUGE!
- Nooga Paws (North Shore) locally owned pet store & custom bakery
- Yellow Racket Records (Main St.) excellent source for new & used vinyl; frequently hosts listening parties
- Winder Binder Mercantile (North Shore) Chattanooga-themed gifts; also sells books & music
