


My Rotation Schedule and Curriculum (not all programs link to each rotation's curriculum in NI)

Surgical disciplines will log cases and procedures via the ACGME Case Log System instead of in New Innovations.




- 1. Call In-House/Overnight

- 4. EM Residents Weekly Conference
- 5. Home Call (Called in)
- 6. Home Call (Not called in)
- 7. Moonlighting
- 8. Night Float
- 9. Post Call/Transitions in Duty
- 10. Regular Duty Hours
- No scheduled shift should ever be logged or worked longer than 24 hours.
- You can remain after 24 hours and log it as #9 Post Call/Transitions in Duty.







New Innovations Mobile App

New Innovations Mobile App

- Residents may use the NI Mobile App to
 - Complete assigned evaluations
 - Enter or revise Work Hours
 (Unfortunately Vacation cannot be logged via the App)
 - Enter Procedures or Diagnosis if NI is used for this by your program (non-surgical)
 - Open the QR Code Scanner tile in the NI Mobile App to scan Conference Codes and take your attendance (if used by your program)
 - Add or view a Direct Observation assessment if used by your program)
