TN STATE BOARD OF DENTISTRY APPROVED PROCEDURES FOR EFDA'S IN RESTORATIVE AND PROSTHETIC FUNCTIONS AS DELEGATED IN THE "RULES OF TN BOARD OF DENTISTRY, CHAPTER 0460-05".

RESTORATIVE:

1. Placement, Carving and Finishing of Composite and Amalgam Fillings.
2. Placement of Dental Dams.
3. Placement of Liners and Bases (NOT removal of old bases and liners).
4. Placement of Matrix Band Retainers.

PROSTHETIC:

1. Border Molding and Master Impressions for Removable Prosthesis.
2. Master Impressions for Fixed Pros (Crown and Bridge).
3. Temporary Fabrication.
4. Placement of Retraction Cord around the Tooth.

*NO, you CANNOT Permanently Cement Final Crown and Bridgework on patients.

*You CANNOT use HIGHSPEED HANDPIECES IN THE MOUTH.
