RESEARCH AND LEARNING SERVICES

Department Accomplishments:

- Created a Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP) Resource Portal to support the UTHSC educational program development and implementation towards Social Determinants of Health.
- Tested and implemented LibInsight, a statistic tracking system, to track, collect, and report department statistics.
- Updated and created additional content for a learning module via the Blackboard: Plagiarism: How to Avoid It. The module was included in the new student orientation for the College of Nursing and for some departments in the College of Health Professions.



WEBSITE UPDATE
