

- You'll need to take a paper or electronic copy of the eval with you to give to your preceptor.




International Electives

- LCME requirements
 - http://www.uthsc.edu/Medicine/students/international.php
 - Completed all core clerkships
 - 8 weeks notice
 - Overseas mentor
 - Develop learning objectives
 - Letter of Acceptance
 - Complete application form
 - Mentor information
 - Must receive a grade
 - Must complete course evaluation
 - Seek approval from Sr Assistant Dean of Clinical Curriculum

Between Blocks 5-10:

- 1 JI
- 1 Elective
- 3rd rotation for LOR (either JI or elective)
- Option block for Step 2 CK
- Any remaining Core Clerkships

Interviews:

- Typically, mid-October through mid-January
- Take Option blocks in 11 & 12

Between Blocks 5-9:


- 1 JI (@ UT)
- Away rotations (2-3)
- Option block for Step 2 CK
- Any remaining Core Clerkships

Interviews:

- Military typically interview during Away rotations
- Ophtho/Urology interviews Oct-Dec
 - Take Option Blocks 11 & 12



Competitive Match – Ortho, ENT, EM, Derm, Surgery



Between Blocks 5-9:

- 1 JI or Elective (@ UT)
- Away rotations (2-3)
- Option block for Step 2 CK
- Any remaining Core Clerkships

Interviews:

- Typically, Dec & Jan
- Take Option blocks in 12 & 1



Exceptions

- Please contact Dr. Bettin if you need an exception to one of the publication rules or have special circumstances:
 - You have fewer than 3 option blocks or
 - Need your interviews in a block other than blocks 11-1
 - You have more than one clerkship to makeup
 - You are graduating in December
- If you are couples' matching, contact Dr. Bettin!



Duplicate Rotations

- If you have duplicate rotations (especially JIs) on your schedule), you will be removed from both rotations prior to the publication date.
- Please only schedule 2 Jls during the first round of scheduling.
- Once everyone has 2 Jls, then we will allow interested students to schedule a third!

New: Required Clinical Experiences

- Geriatrics-Palliative Medicine now has RCEs:
 - 1. Facilitate a discussion of code status
 - 2. Perform a geriatric assessment
 - 3. Conduct an end-of-life discussion
 - 4. Create a hospice plan of care
 - 5. Conduct a medication review in a geriatric patient
- These will be added to eMedley and must be logged in eClas for your rotation.



Step 2 CK Reminder

- Remember to schedule your Step 2 CK exam!
 - Deadline is October 31, 2022
- Complete all core clerkships first or request an exception from Dr. Whitt or Dr. Bettin.
- If taking Step 2 prior to finishing clerkships:
 - Must take and pass an NBME practice exam by ≥ 10 points
 - Email results to Drs. Whitt and Bettin
