The NEPQR-SET grant will enhance nurse education and strengthen the nursing workforce by increasing training opportunities for nursing students using simulation-based technology and expanding the capacity of nurses to advance the health of patients, families, and communities in rural and medically underserved areas. In collaboration with new and existing academic-clinical partnerships, the grant team will train **250 or more** undergraduate and graduate nursing students annually via equity-focused simulation experiences using standardized patients and other experiential methodologies.

Dr. Manasco's role is to oversee faculty and staff on the project. She is responsible for budget administration. She conducts regular meetings to monitor progress, synthesize results of evaluation data, provide oversight of all grant reporting, and disseminate the results. Dr. Manasco will ensure all project deliverables are met and reporting is completed.

The NEPQR-MHTP grant will increase and strengthen the diversity, education, and training of the nursing workforce to provide culturally aligned quality care in Lake and Lauderdale counties of West Tennessee, two rural counties with health care disparities related to access and delivery of care. A nurse-led mobile health unit (MHU) will provide care to vulnerable populations of Lake and Lauderdale counties. The MHU will also provide longitudinal clinical training opportunities (>80 hours) for BSN and DNP students who participate in the *BSN Micro-credentialing Program* and *DNP Scholars Program*. The aim of the grant is to promote students' competency in assessing, identifying, and addressing the social determinants of health and healthcare needs of rural and underserved populations.

Dr. Manasco's role is to lead the development, implementation, and ongoing success of the *BSN Micro-credentialing Program*, a concept-oriented, competency-based micro-credentialing program for BSN students that uses the MHU for experiential learning. The micro-credentialing program consists of eight independent micro-credential modules centered around selected concepts and competencies that prepare nurse graduates capable of improving health equity, access, and outcomes for vulnerable populations.



Each micro-credential module will consist of three phases: *Learn It, Do It, and Show It*, as well as 15 prescribed hours of high-impact, experiential learning on the MHU. Students will receive a medallion and financial stipend for each module completed. Students who complete all eight modules graduate with the distinction of the *Rural and Underserved Nurse*.
