- Grew and recruited faculty from 27 individuals to over 65 while maintaining a diverse workforce, with over 35% of faculty being from underrepresented groups
- Submitted a New Academic Program Proposal (NAPP) to the Tennessee Higher Education Committee for a joint BSN program with UT Southern, the first joint BSN program in the University of Tennessee system
- Developed 2 centers of excellence: Center for Community and Global Partnerships and the Margaret A. Newman Center for Nursing Theory
- Enhanced use of technology: Added a faculty workload tracking tool, CRM, and admission management tool and developed a detailed evaluation plan. Currently placing the data plan into a software system to create dashboards
- Secured resources through philanthropy: instituted first fully funded BSN scholarship for the College, established the second Endowed Chair and second Endowed Professorship in the CON, created a student emergency fund that is now endowed, secured \$1.2 million each year for 3 years from local corporations to scholarship students, grew donors from less than 300 to over 530, established 13 new endowed scholarships since 2015 (college previously had 12)
- Grew grant awards from less than \$700,000 in 2015 to over \$5.8 million to date in FY2024
- Increased visibility and reputation of the College: according to *US News and World Report*, BSN program ranked #39 (highest in Tennessee) and DNP ranked #27 (top 15% in the country); became a National League for Nursing Center of Excellence in Enhancing Student Learning and Professional Development (2021-2025); ~50 media mentions in 2023
