Orientation

Students will report to St. Jude at 7:00 am on Monday. Students may enter the hospital through any of the entrance gates; their name will be on the visitor list. The orientation will be held in the **Barry Building** on the <u>3rd floor in room S-3040</u>. A schedule for the week will be provided to each student at orientation. Clinics normally begin between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and end between 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. The clinic experience will be a mix of shadowing and performing histories/physical exams as indicated by the clinic attending physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants and clinic managers.
