Choice of electives are made in collaboration with advisor and program directors.

Fellows can have a maximum of 2 non-Clinical elective blocks each PGY year (unless permission by program director).

- 2. Non-teaching Attending Only service*
- 3. Infectious Disease
- 4. Palliative Care
- 5. Child Abuse
- 6. St Jude Hematology/Oncology**
- 7. Infectious Disease, Palliative Care, or Child Abuse.

*Non-Teaching Attending Only Service will be encouraged

**St Jude Hematology/Oncology during PGY5 is a full block and permission by the program director will be needed to replace elective.

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For Non-Clinical Electives:

- 1. Research
- 2. Advocacy / Medical Legal Partnership (1 unit),
- 3. Leadership / Management (0.5)
