REQUIREMENTS

Applications for the PhD program are accepted from students with a BS or MS degree in pharmacy, chemistry, biology, mathematics, engineering, or other appropriate disciplines.

We only enroll students within the fall semester.

- A minimum grade point average of 3.0
- Personal and research statements
- A combined score (verbal and quantitative) of at least 300 on the Graduate Record Examination (GRE)
- Native language must be English or have graduated from an institution where English is the common language
- If native language is not English, TOEFL or IELTS exam is required
- Three letters of recommendation
- CV

No application fee is charged with an electronic application.

FINANCIAL AID

We offer a tuition wavier, stipend and health insurance.

Students are encouraged to apply for other fellowships

FOR NON-US APPLICANTS

Official GRE and TOFL test scores and three letters of recommendation should be sent directly from the contributing source and not by the student to the Office of Enrollment Services.

Transcripts from any non-US institution MUST be verified and certified to generate a grade point average (GPA).

Service agencies, include, but are not limited to, Educational Credit Evaluation (ECE) at ece.org, World Education Services (WES) at wes.org, and American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (AACRAO) at aacrao.org.

A document-by-document certification is not acceptable.
