UTHSC Retiree AND Master Gardener Gardening Smart

Besides the usual things you need to consider, such as

- what you want to include in your garden, flowers, vegetables, herbs, water feature or a combination
- how much time you want to actually want to spend on planting and maintenance
- whether you have shady or sunny areas.

You should consider the tools you might need

- what kind of shovel/spade
- pruning tools
- · hand cultivation tools
- ladder

Keep your tools in good working order and sharpened. If you are using a ladder, be certain it is the height you need, that it is sturdy and in good condition.

Be aware of insects making a home near your garden (e.g. wasps, bees) and decide how you want to deal with them. Some insects are beneficial and needed for pollination or pest control.

Some plants that need to be cleared or have taken up residence should be studied. There might be poison ivy or oak. If you are allergic, consider help in removing them.

And have fun and enjoy your efforts.
