# FROM THE PRESIDENT

By now, I am certain that all UTHSC retirees are aware of the Administration's decision to cancel email accounts that were a part of our retirement benefits package.

I would like to make some points that are essential to the issue and reflect my assessment of this new policy. As President of the UTHSC Retirees Association. I was invited to a joint meeting with representatives from the UT IT Department and Human Resources. At that time I was informed that due to IT security issues surrounding email accounts, the university would no longer offer email accounts to retirees. HR's research into the matter has revealed that other academic institutions and corporate entities terminate all email access to employees once their employment has ended. UT has decided to adopt a similar policy. It was expressed to the UT representatives the enormous hardship that this new policy would create that include, but not limited to, a number of retirees use their email accounts to facilitate business interests and the financial burden this policy would create. At this point, I do not wish to be condescending, nor do I want to be patronizing, but I did not get the sense, after having voiced the aforementioned concerns, that I had any impact in reversing this policy.

Now, it is time for the Retiree Association to be heard. I have invited the Directors of the UT IT and Human Resources Department to speak at our Luncheon meeting on Thursday, September 19, 2019 at 11:30am in Room 305 SAC to give more details of this policy to ALL interested parties. I would like to see you there and bring your questions and passion surrounding this critical issue.

## MADISON PLAZA FRONT ENTRANCE CLOSING FOR RENOVATIONS
