## NOTES FROM GUEST SPEAKER

**NATHANIEL BOUTTE, PHARM.D**

*PrEP and PEP 101*

Dr. Boutte is a 2011 graduate of UTHSC and now is the manager at Community, a local Specialty Walgreen's,

Dr. Boutte spoke of the program at his pharmacy dealing with HIV. He explained that PrEP was Pre-exposure Prophylaxis and who the candidates were including heterosexual men and women and intravenous drug users.

PEP is Post-Exposure Prophylaxis and must be started within 72 hours of a possible exposure to HIV. Candidates for PEP: if you are HIV-negative or don't know your HIV status and in the last 72 hours you a) think you may have been exposed to HIV during sex b) shared needles or works to prepare drugs or c) were sexually assaulted.

Introducing for a return engagement, our September 20th Luncheon Speaker, Cathy C. Faust, MS, CFCS, Extension Agent III, University of Tennessee Institute of Agriculture, Shelby County Extension Office.

"I have been an Extension Agent with the University of Tennessee Extension Service in Shelby County for nearly 29 years. I graduated from Southeastern Louisiana University with a degree in Home Economics (now called Family & Consumer Sciences.) I earned my Master's Degree from the University of Tennessee in Knoxville.

In Extension, we cover everything from the farm to the fork. My teaching emphasis is on financial management. I conduct the court-mandated Debtor Education Classes for clients completing their Chapter 13 Bankruptcy.
